- Every class offered which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current USEF, VHSA, BHSA, VSCHSA rule books will be conducted and judged accordingly. The judge's decision is final.
- 2. A.S.T.M./S.E.I. approved helmets with harnesses required for all juniors and must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Same hats for ALL in jumping classes.
- 3. Current negative coggins required for each horse entry.
- 4. Exhibitors ride at their own risk: Pursuant VA Code Annotated Title 3.2-6200-6203.
- 5. Proper show attire is required in order to be judged.
- 6. All ages are as of December 1, 2011.
- KFEC points for year-end awards will be calculated as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> 10 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> 6pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> 4pts, 4<sup>th</sup> 2pts, 5<sup>th</sup> 1 pt, 6<sup>th</sup> .5pt, Champion 10pts and Reserve Champion 6pts. Prizes will be awarded for Champion and Reserve.
- 8. The Show Officials and Equestrian Center Staff reserve the right to refuse any entry, to change, combine, cancel, split classes or change officials.
- 9. Kelly's Ford Equestrian Center and it's employees and volunteers are not responsible for any accident or loss which may occur on the show grounds.
- 10. Schooling is permitted in the main show arena until 9:00 a.m. and during the lunch break. Schooling in the Jumper Arena begins at 12 noon but courses are open for walking before then. Warm-up hunter classes are not to be judged but we ask riders to excuse themselves after three refusals.
- 11. All dogs must be kept on leashes or left at home. No exceptions.
- 12. Any pony ridden in pony restricted divisions (IE. Pony Hunter) CANNOT be ridden by an adult.

Handy Hunter– Open to ponies 2' or 2'6" and horses 2', 2'6", or 3'. (1 pony/horse at only 1 height. Course may include: trot, fence, roll back, broken lines, and one obstacle (Opening a gate, opening a mailbox, or crossing a bridge). Judge will award additional handy points (0-10) to open numeric scoring (0-100) for the jumps and obstacle.

Working Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a Pony Division. Fences 3'.

#### Virginia Horse Show Association Medal Classes

**General Medal Rules** - Contestant must be a regular member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II,3. There must be at least three exhibitors to fill the class and three exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. Medal classes cannot be combined with any other VHSA Medal or any other Division/Class. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. Fall of pony or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. Judges may require riders to change horses, mount, dismount, or exhibit any other individual requirements of equitation they may deem necessary.

VHSA Pony Equitation Medal Class - Open to Regular Junior Members of the VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday. To be ridden on ponies over a course of not less than 6 obstacles; 2'3" for ponies not exceeding 12.2 hands, 2'6" for ponies over 12.2 hands and not exceeding 13.2 hands, and ponies over 13.2 hands not exceeding 14.2 hands jump 3'. Judges may at their discretion test the top four riders. Jumping faults of mount not to count. A minimum of twelve rider, if available, will be asked to return to show at a walk, trot and canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. Martingales are prohibited on the flat. Entrants in this class may not compete in the VHSA Hunter Seat Medal Class at the same show. VHSA Children's Medal Class - Open to Regular Junior members of VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not jumped higher than three feet at a show where entered in the Children's Hunter Division, except in Equitation. Open to horses only. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. Beginning with the 2011Show Year the VHSA Children's Medal Class no longer has a flat phase. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing.

VHSA Adult Amateur Medal Class - Open to horses only. Contestant must hold a current amateur card issued by USEF. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. Rider may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches, with the exception of the Children/Adult Jumper Division, at the same show. Beginning with the 2011 Show Year the VHSA Adult Medal Class no longer has a flat phase. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing. Jumping faults of mount not to count.

#### JUMPER DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

Puddle Jumper - Horses, ponies, and riders may only cross enter into any other class not exceeding 3' if otherwise eligible.

**Novice Jumper** - Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/11. May only cross enter into Puddle Jumper and Low Jumper and any other classes under 3'.

Low Jumper - Open to horses and ponies, no restriction on riders (Exceptions: see Puddle Jumper, Novice Jumper).

**Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper** - Open to horses ridden by juniors and horses or ponies not showing an a pony division ridden by Adult Amateurs. Jump height to be a minimum of 2'6". The division will be split if entries warrant. (Exceptions see General Kelly's Ford Show rule #12)

Schooling Jumper - Open to horses and ponies, no restriction on riders.

Modified Jumper - Open to horses and ponies, no restriction on riders.

**USEF Table II, Sec. 2 (b)** - The first round and jump off if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If the competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor upon audible signal will commence the designated jump off course. **USEF Table II, Sec. 2 (c)** - The first phase is to consist of 8-10 jumping efforts and the second phase (immediate jump-off) of 5-7 jumping efforts. Scores are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed, if any. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, he will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the designated jump-off course.

#### HUNTER & EQUITATION DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

**Leadline** - Open to riders 7 and under as of 12/1/11. Riders not allowed to cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to trot. Rider not eligible for any other classes and must not have competed in any class other than Leadline. Rider to be led at the walk. Pony to be on lead at all tines. Division consists of there classes: (1) 100% pony suitability and manners; (2) 100% rider equitation; and (3) 50% equitation/50% pony suitability. To be judged 50% equitation and 50% suitability of mount. Points go to rider.

**Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation** - Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1/11.Judged on Equitation. Riders may be asked to walk, trot, and perform simple Equitation tasks. Riders are not allowed to cross enter into classes in which they would be asked to canter or jump.

**Short Stirrup Hunter -** Open to riders 12 years and under as of 12/1/11. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". Courses may be trotted.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Open to riders 12 years and under as of 12/1/11. Judged on equitation. Jumps may not exceed 18". Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". Courses may be trotted.

**Student Equitation** – Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/1/11. Jumps to be a minimum of 2'. Riders competing in the Student Equitation Division are limited to two years only. Whether they compete over fences or not. To be judged as an equitation division. Points to go to the rider. Courses may be trotted. No oxers.

Hunter Pleasure Pony - Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going.

Hunter Pleasure Horse - Open to any horse. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. To be split Adult Pleasure Horse and Jr. Pleasure Horse if entries warrant.

**Maiden Hunter** - Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/1/11. No restrictions on riders Jump height to be a minimum of 2'. Courses may be trotted if stated in the Prize List.

Limit Rider Hunter - Open to horses or ponies. Riders must be juniors or adult amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. These riders are not eligible to compete in VHSA Adult Amateur Equitation, VHSA Pony Equitation, or VHSA Children's Equitation. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses/ ponies may be cross –entered into other divisions,. Courses to be a minimum of 6 fences set a 2'3". Low Hunter - Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders.

Fences 2' or 2'3".

**Green Hunter** - Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/11. Fences set at 2'6".Open to ponies in their first year of showing at regulation heights as of 12/1/11 ridden only by Juniors. Fences: Small 2'0", Medium 2'3", Large 2'6". Combined with Green Pony Hunter, may be split if entries warrant.

**Pony Equitation Classic** – Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. Small ponies to jump a minimum of 2'. Medium ponies to jump a minimum 2'3" and Large ponies to jump a minimum of 2'6". The judge will select at least 1/4 of the class to show at the walk, trot and canter, and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion.

**Pony Hunter** – Open to ponies ridden by juniors. The division will be split to Small/Medium and Large ponies if entries warrant. Jump heights: Small ponies to jump a minimum of 2', Medium ponies to jump a minimum of 2'3", and Large ponies to be a minimum of 2'6" and not to exceed 3'.

Virginia Pony Breeders Association - Open to Junior riders on ponies that are properly registered with the VPBA, exhibited under their registered name and in the name of its last recorded owner who must be a current member of the VPBA for points to count for SCHSA year end awards. Small/medium ponies jump 2' and large ponies jump 2'6".

The Forrest Linton Memorial Classic (BHSA) - Open to all ponies or open to all horses depending on date. Pony riders must be juniors. Two-Round using numeric scoring. The jump order for the second round will start with the lowest score going first to the highest score to be the last at each height. A minimum of 10 to return for the second round if available. Jump heights, riders choice to be 2' or 2'6", (ponies) or 2'6" or 3', (horses).

**Children/Adult Amateur Equitation Classic-** Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs on horses. Fences 2'6" or 3'0". At least <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the class will be asked to return to show on the flat and to perform additional tests at the Judge's discretion. The division will be split if entries warrant.

**Children/Adult Amateur Hunter** - Open to horses ridden by Juniors and horses or ponies not showing in a pony division ridden by Adult Amateurs. Fences 2'6 or 3'0". The division will be split if entries warrant.

#### DIRECTIONS:

<u>From Warrenton</u>: Route 29 South to Elkwood. Turn left on Kelly's Ford Road (Route 674). Go 5 miles to Edward's Shop Road (Route 620). Then go  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile on Edward's Shop Road. Kelly's Ford Equestrian Center is on left – turn in first entrance.

<u>From Charlottesville</u>: Route 29 North to Elkwood. Turn right on Kelly's Ford Road (Route 674). Go 5 miles to Edward's Shop Road (Route 620). Then go  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile on Edward's Shop Road. Kelly's Ford Equestrian Center is on left – turn in first entrance.

<u>From Fredericksburg</u>: Take Route 3 West past Lake of the Woods. Just past Germanna Community College at the Shell station, turn right on Yellow Bottom Road (Route 620). Go approximately 2.5 miles to stop sign and turn left on Ely's Ford Road (Route 610). Go approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile and turn right back on Edward's Shop Road (Route 620). Go 5 miles (over New 2 Lane Bridge!) and turn right into third entrance at The Inn at Kelly's Ford.
